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(1) Rahab and the Scarlet Rope (Joshua Chapter 2,6)

1. Why did Joshua send the spies to Jericho?

Possible Answers:

❖ Their mission was to <u>explore the city and learn everything about it</u> so they would be able to conquer it and take over the land that God has promised to give His people (The Land of Canaan). [Pg10]

2. What did the spies ask Rahab to do?

Possible Answers:

❖ They told her, to <u>tie a scarlet (red) rope</u> and let it down the same window they escaped from. They also asked her to <u>bring her</u> father, mother, brothers, and all her <u>family to her house</u>. [pg11]

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3. Saint Ephraim the Syrian (Synaxarium 15th of Abib)

<u>Direction:</u> Dear Servants, Please ask each child the following questions. Make sure to read each part of the question <u>SEPARETLY</u>. And allow the child to answer after each part.

1. What is the name of the desert St. Ephraim the Syrian visited in Egypt? How many years did he spend there?

Possible Answers:

- ❖ Saint Ephraim went to visit Egypt, while visiting he came to the desert Wadi El-Natroun
 - ❖ Saint Ephraim lived there for <u>8 years</u>. [pg26]

- 2. When St. Ephraim the Syrian visited St. Bishoy at the desert, he left his staff outside. What did St. Ephraim's staff turn into??

Possible Answers:

- ❖ The staff sprouted and grew into <u>a beautiful big tree</u>. [pg26]

4. The Shunammite Woman and her Service to Elisha the Prophet (2Kings 4:8-18)

<u>Direction:</u> Dear Servants, please ask each child the following questions. Make sure to read each part of the question <u>SEPARETLY</u>. And allow the child to answer after each part.

1) What did the Shunammite woman ask her husband to build? And Why? Possible Answers:

- ❖ She asked her husband to build Elisha an <u>upper room</u> on the roof of her house and <u>furnish it</u> with a bed, a table for eating and reading and a lamp to light the room.
- ❖ She wanted Elisha to rest when he comes to their house. [pg32]

- 2. Elisha wanted to offer the Shunammite woman and her husband a reward. For what? And what did Elisha tell her will happen next year?

Possible Answers:

- ❖ . Elisha wanted to offer a reward for the Shunammite Woman and her husband <u>because they were so kind to him.</u> He wanted to offer something nice to her and her husband in return.
- Elisha told the woman, about this time next year <u>you shall have a son</u>. (pg32,33)
