My Cross in My Church and is With Me Everywhere

Parent Question Guide

1. What is the cross a source of?

Answer: The cross gives power to all God's children everywhere they go.

2. When did the cross become the source of all power?

Answer: The cross became the source of all power when Our Lord Jesus Christ was crucified on the cross and redeemed us.

3. What is the meaning of the word "Cross"?

Answer: The cross is the power of God. The Bible says, "To us who are being saved it is the power of God." 1 Corinthians 1:18.

4. How does God give us strength?


Answer: God gives us strength through the cross.

5. Why do we use the cross everywhere we go?

Answer: We use the cross everywhere because it gives us strength.

6. Where do we see the cross?





Answer: We see the cross on top of the church tower, in Abouna's hand, on top of the altar, in Baptism, in Chrismation, and during church processions.

Answer: The cross is in high places to show everyone that the church belongs to Our Lord Jesus Christ and obeys God's word.

8. Why does Abouna hold a cross?

Answer: Abouna holds the cross to bless all the people.

Answer: When we see Abouna coming, we should run to him, kiss the cross, and kiss his hand.

Answer: The cross is in the middle of the iconostasis with the saints' pictures.

Answer: The cross reminds us that through the cross the gates of Heaven were opened, and many saints are in Heaven.

Answer: We see the cross when Abouna makes the sign of the cross over the water and baptizes/immerses the baby in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Abouna immerses the baby three times in the water.

Answer: Chrismation happens after Baptism.

2. When do we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Cross in the Church of the Resurrection?

Answer: We celebrate the Feast of the Holy Cross in the Church of the Resurrection on Tout 17.

3. How many times do we celebrate the Feast of the Cross?

Answer: We celebrate the Feast of the Cross two times every year.

4. What year did Queen Helen find the Holy Cross?

Answer: Queen Helen found the Holy Cross in the year 326 AD, about 17 centuries ago.

5. Who is Queen Helen?

Answer: Queen Helen is the mother of Emperor Constantine the Great.

6. Who gave Queen Helen the desire to find the Holy Cross?

Answer: God gave Queen Helen the desire to find the Holy Cross.

7. What did Queen Helen do when she wanted to find the Holy Cross?

Answer: Queen Helen traveled to Jerusalem with 3000 soldiers to look for the Holy Cross where Our Lord Jesus Christ was crucified.

8. Did Queen Helen find the cross easily?

Answer: No, Queen Helen searched for a very long time and could not find the cross easily. Later, someone told her about a very old Jewish man.

9. What did the old Jewish man know about?

Answer: The old Jewish man knew where the wood of the Holy Cross was hidden.

10. What did Queen Helen do when she heard that the old Jewish man knew where the cross was?

Answer: Queen Helen brought the old Jewish man to her and asked him where the Holy Cross was hidden.

Answer: At first the old man would not tell her, but later he told her that the cross was hidden under a big pile of garbage.

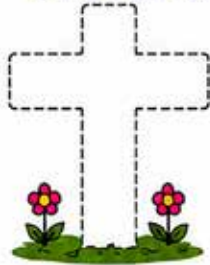

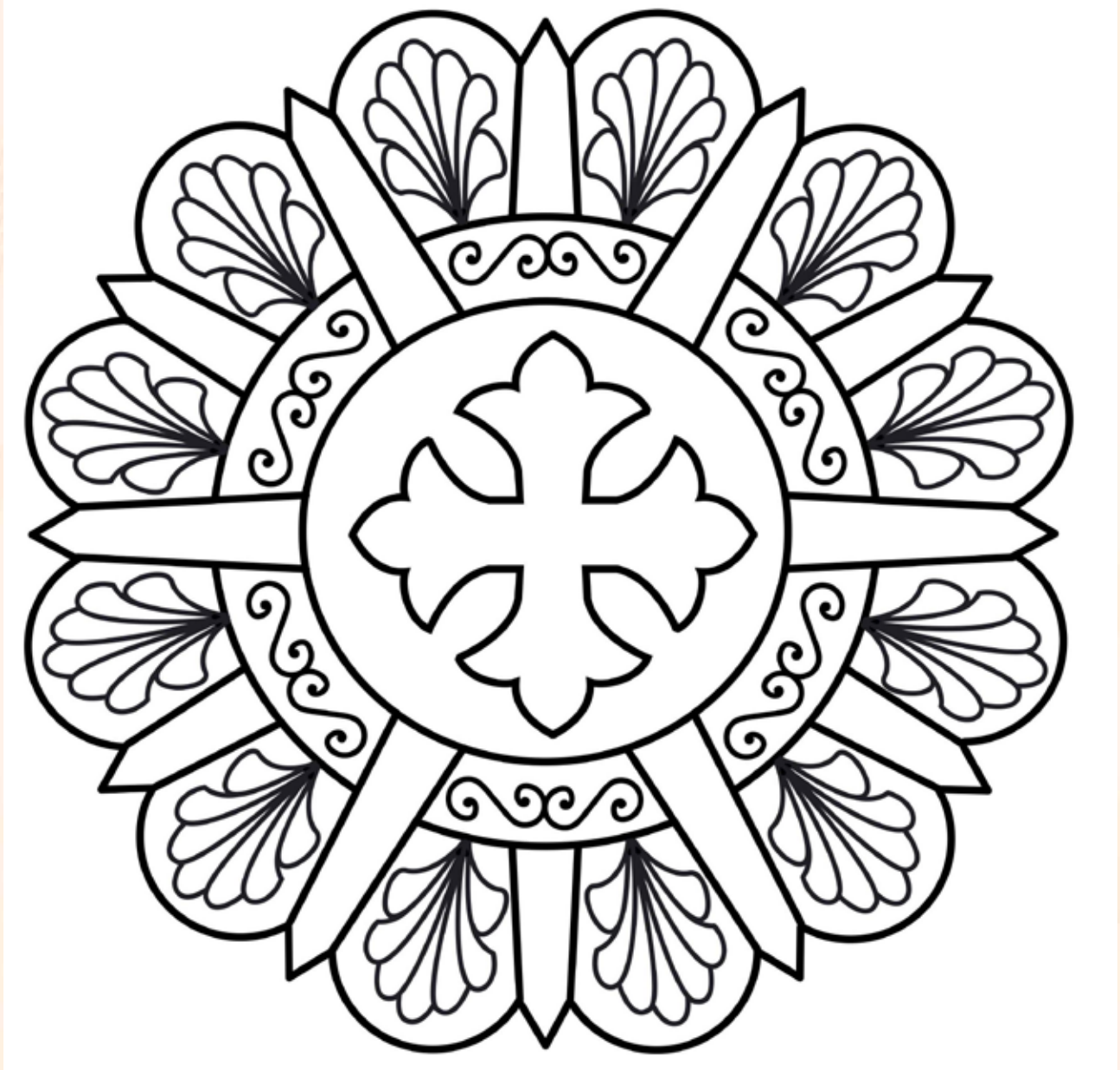
